Disciple Now centers around small group discipleship in a home setting for a weekend. Each group will have 10-12 students and will be led by a specific adult or college leader. The weekend is composed of Bible study, recreation, and relationship building activities. Each session builds on the previous session so it is important for students to attend the entire weekend!
